**Provenance:** The Sophie Barcus Radio Program Collection was the property of Sophie Barcus. The collection was passed on to Sophie Barcus' daughter, Aldona (Barcus) Daukus, and her husband Feliksas Daukus. After Feliksas Daukus' death, the collection was owned by Feliksas and Aldona's daughter, Sophia Daukus. Sophia Daukus donated this collection to Lithuanian Archives Project in 2012. LAP currently owns this collection.

### **Biographical Sketch**

The Sophie Barcus Radio Program began airing in Chicago in 1932 and ran for 54 consecutive years. It served as a source of information about Lithuanian culture for Lithuanian immigrants in Chicago. After 1949 the show helped post-World War II immigrants adapt to life in the United States.

### **Scope and Content**

The Sophie Barcus Radio Program Collection contains xx linear feet spanning the years 1920-2016. The collection includes recordings of the radio program in various formats, radio equipment, scripts and props from the program, personal effects of Sophie Barcus, photographs, and digitized recordings of the radio program.

### **Series Information**

#### **Series 1: Recordings, 1932-1986**

This series contains recordings of the Sophie Barcus Radio Program in various formats, primarily wire and magnetic tape. **Note:** Though some of the recordings are numbered, the majority are not, and the numbers do not seem to correspond to date or recording order.

## **Series 2: Personal Effects and Miscellaneous Items, 1920-1978**

This series contains personal effects belonging to Sophie Barcus, including her wallet and eyeglasses. It also includes miscellaneous items from the radio program, such as a 1978 survey of the program's listeners, props, and scripts.

## **Series 3: Photographs**

This series contains both original photographs and digitized copies. Subjects include photographs taken inside the studio, Red Cross events, banquets, picnics, and personal family photographs. The digitized photographs are stored on a hard drive.

## **Series 4: Digitized Recordings, 2015-2016**

This series contains digitized audio of the recordings of the Sophie Barcus Radio Program. The digitized files are stored on a hard drive.
